



## **South Bromsgrove win Army Schools Sevens**

- Worcestershire school South Bromsgrove take sevens crown
- Army West Midlands Schools Sevens a success yet again

South Bromsgrove HS from Worcestershire are this season's Army West Midlands Schools Sevens Festival champions.

South Bromsgrove beat Woodlands School from Coventry three tries to two in the final played at Stourbridge's Stourton Park ground.

South Bromsgrove had earlier finished second in their pool behind Woodlands and then edged out St Augustine's from Redditch 1-0 in a close semi-final. Woodlands beat Polesworth School from Staffordshire 4-1 in their semi-final.

This was the ninth season of the popular Army-sponsored event which involved 1,260 players aged 16 and under in Years 10 and 11 in a series of regional qualifying tournaments across the West Midlands to produce the qualifiers for finals day.

Polesworth won the girls contact tournament by beating Nunnery Wood from Worcestershire 3-1 in the final.

Polesworth had finished second to Nunnery Wood in their group but then beat President Kennedy School from Warwickshire 2-1 in the semi-finals. Nunnery Wood beat Painsley from Staffordshire 2-0 in their semi-final.

The girls Tag title went to Evesham HS who topped the league of five schools.
